 - * Applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 and plan to attend or attending a 2 or 4-year college or technical school.
 - * Graduating senior applicants must have an ACT score of **19 or above**.
 - * Applicant must be a **resident of Carter County**.
 - * Applicant **need** level will be determined by the **FASFA** criteria.
 - * **Submit a 250 – 500 word essay on chosen topic.**
 - * Scholarship funds will be paid ***in August 2019 for Spring semester and January 2020 for Fall semester.***
- **The applicant will be responsible for submitting an invoice, student ID number, college name, address and phone number. *****
